

Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

February 14th, celebrated as St. Valentine's Day by many, will also begin our Lenten observance as we celebrate Ash Wednesday. Two different times for Ash Wednesday have been published, which was my fault, as I accidentally changed it in a recent bulletin column. Originally Mass was scheduled for 6:30 am, but I recently wrote that it was at 6:15, which was published in bulletins for both Lincoln/Rosiere and Brussels. In light of the latest communication, **Ash Wednesday will be at 6:15am in Brussels.** I actually think the extra fifteen minutes will be helpful to make sure people have enough time to get to work since we will be distributing ashes which adds to the length of the celebration. Other Ash Wednesday times are 8am (Mass) in Rosiere, 8am (Liturgy of the Word with Ashes and Communion) Brussels, 5:30pm Lincoln, 7:15pm in Brussels.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence, so please celebrate St. Valentine's day with your loved ones on Mardi Gras Day! Here are the guidelines from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops: *For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.*

During the Lenten season many people like to pray the Stations of the Cross, which help us to meditate on Christ's passion and death. **Stations will take place in Rosiere on Mondays at 6pm and in Lincoln on Sundays after the 10:15 am Mass.** Please join us as we fall in love with Lent this year.
