This past Wednesday we inaugurated our year of Religious Education with a joint Mass between Brussels, Lincoln, and Rosiere, hosted at the Rosiere Church. There are a few changes in the RE program, first with start times that are more friendly family and with a new curriculum. We also will be introducing a monthly Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) to supplement our religious education classes.
