Dear Parishioners,

Each year at the Easter Vigil, the Church welcomes new members who wish to be baptized or make a profession of faith. Growing up, I knew many of my peers were never baptized by their parents, because they wanted the child to choose their faith, rather than impose a belief system on them. This has led to an increase of adult baptisms in our current day and age. Also at the Easter Vigil, individuals baptized in a different faith tradition (Lutheran, Methodist, etc.) can make a profession of faith, thereby converting to the Catholic faith.

It is that time of the year for us to begin RCIA, the process by which adults go through a period of instruction and prayer as a way to prepare for the Easter Sacraments. Do you know someone who isn't baptized? Or someone who wants to convert to the faith? It could be someone in your family or community, or even yourself. Last year at the Easter Vigil we welcomed three new members into the Catholic Church, 1 for Brussels, and 2 for Lincoln/Rosiere.
