Dear Parishioners,

My hope is that many of our parishioners have prayed the rosary during this month of October. If not everyday, I hope at least a few times this month. As a promoter of the rosary devotion, I've tried to help people discover the richness of the rosary. One way I've done this is through my devotional book *A Rosary Litany*, now available from Our Sunday Visitor. Another tip I often offer people, is to formulate a petition for each mystery of the rosary. Here are a few intentions I pray for with their corresponding mystery:

Joyful Mysteries

Annunciation: For vocations

Visitation: That pregnant mothers will have a safe delivery

Nativity: For those struggling with infertility

Presentation: For the families of our recently baptized children

Finding in the Temple: For those people who are searching for God

Luminous

Baptism in the Jordan: For all children recently baptized

Wedding at Cana: For those engaged, and newly married couples

Proclamation: For those who need to hear the good news of the gospel

Transfiguration: For your best friends

Last Supper: For those away from the Sunday Eucharist

Sorrowful

Agony: For anyone making a tough decision

Scourging: For those who suffer injustice

Crowning with Thorns: For civil leaders

Way of the Cross: For those suffering trials and difficulties

Crucifixion: For the ability to forgive those who have wronged us.

Glorious

Resurrection: For our loved ones who have died

Ascension: That we might become disciples of the Lord

Pentecost: For a renewal of the Holy Spirit in my life

Assumption: For the grace of a happy and holy death

Coronation: For those who struggle with devotion to Mary

These are a few of my suggestions of how we can pray for others while we meditate on the life of Jesus and Mary through the rosary. Let us pray for each other, our parish, and the world.
