As the first few days of 2019 are complete, how are you doing with your New Year's Resolutions to eat better, exercise more, and any other goal we might have? Hopefully after just a few days you are still going strong. My question to you would be this: Did you make a spiritual New Year's Resolutions? How will you better your relationship with God in 2019? Here are a few suggestions I proposed in a recent article for *Catholic Digest*:

- Pray the Morning the Offering
- Learn how to pray the rosary, and pray it more frequently
- Observe meatless Fridays throughout the year
- Pray the Stations of the Cross weekly
