Dear Parishioners,

The other day on Twitter I happened upon a prayer a young woman posted. The prayer was one that she prays when her priest receives Holy Communion. I thought it was a beautiful notion. First, it makes us think about our own personal preparation for Holy Communion. Do you say a prayer beforehand or as you walk up the aisle? Before I receive Holy Communion, during the Lamb of God, there is a prayer prescribed for the priest to pray beforehand. There are two versions, here's one: "May the receiving of your body and blood Lord Jesus Christ, not bring me to judgment and condemnation but through your loving mercy be for me protection in mind and body and a healing remedy."

Here's the prayer the young lady posted on Twitter:

O Lord, may Thou find shelter and rest gently within the heart of thy Priest. Make him, O Lord, a priest according to thy Heart: meek, humble, and zealous, so that all he does will be for Thine honor and glory. Mold him into a man of prayer and labor, insensible to earthly things, and sensible only to Thy love and to the graces of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

As a priest, I am grateful for those who pray for me. Some days are difficult, but I know that your prayers sustain me. Please know that as your pastor, I remember you and your families in my daily prayers.

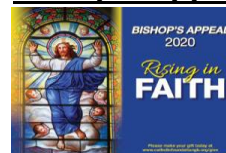
