

## Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

It is hard to believe that four years have passed since my mother's death (9-18-2017). It occurred in the first few months after I arrived in Brussels, Lincoln, and Rosiere. I have held some regret about her death, because I drove by her house a few days earlier and chose not to stop in. That's the thing; we always think we have [tomorrow](#), another month, or another year. I was not present for her death, as it was unexpected. The Brown County Sheriff's department had put out a death notification to Door County to make known the news to me. One parishioner took me to Green Bay to assess the situation. Her visitation and funeral was in Oconto and a good number of parishioners made the drive to offer their condolences the night before or the day of the funeral.

We all have grieved the loss of someone we love. We all mark these anniversaries differently. I hope to make it to Oconto sometime this month to visit the grave. I'll probably enjoy a meal on [Saturday](#) that she would have liked and I will most likely make some peanut butter cookies which the nursing home she worked at named in her memory. On death anniversaries, we are given an opportunity to remember the life of the person, the memories we shared, and to pray for them.

This past week we celebrated the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and Our Lady of Sorrows. The first recalls the triumph of Jesus's death on the cross. The cross is a reminder to us of God's love, his forgiveness, our redemption by his blood, and Christ's humility and obedience. Mary stood faithfully by the cross. She witnessed the death of her son. For those who mourn, know that you have someone you can look to because Mary mourned. She cried. She remembered. But Mary also had hope. She believed what Jesus said. She knew he would rise from the dead. We need to be like Mary, and believe in that gift of eternal life that awaits us. He promised it to the Good Thief, and we hope to attain Heaven, for that is the goal of our life on earth.
