

## *Father Edward's Notebook*

Dear Parishioners,

This past week the Diocese had its annual clergy gathering in Manitowoc. It is at this gathering that received updated information about vocations to the priesthood. This typically comes in the form of a new poster for promotion, some prayer cards, and booklets so you can get to know the seminarians. Some of this literature is in the entryway of the Church. An added bonus this year was the focus on vocations and encouraging priestly vocations from within our parish.

I am sure many of you have daily petitions that you include in your prayers. I'm willing to bet your prayers include your family and children. You pray for their health and well-being, or maybe for their conversion. It is important for all of us to include priestly vocations in our petitionary prayer. It was Jesus himself who told us to pray to the Master of the Harvest to send out more laborers for the vineyard. At present, there are seventeen men in formation for the priesthood in various stages. The stages of formation for men from Green Bay include now an introductory year where they live in community, and read the bible and Catechism of the Catholic Church in their entirety! They ask priests to come in and offer formation nights for the men. Last year I offered a session on Marian devotion in the life of the Church. The typical length for preparation for the priesthood from beginning to end ranges from 7-9 years for a person discerning.

Would you join me in the following prayer:

*Heavenly Father, you are the Lord of the call. Your son Jesus told us to ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. We turn to you now and ask that you send forth your Holy Spirit to awaken the hearts of those whom you are calling to the priesthood in the Diocese of Green Bay. May they hear your call and respond with a profound "yes," just as Mary did when she was asked to become the mother of your son, Jesus. Keep these your sons always close to you in the Eucharist and protect them from all evil. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

As a parish, let us remain united in prayer for an abundance of vocations to the priesthood from our parish and in our diocese.
