

# Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

I'll be away from the dates of October 17-27. Originally I was scheduled to be in France during these ten days, but the uncertainties around Covid-19 cancelled the trip. Since the time was slated to be away, I thought it opportune to take my five day retreat and then to spend five days away on vacation.

My five days of retreat will be in the Chicagoland area, near Mundelein Seminary where I studied. In fact, I'll be right next door at Marytown, a place with perpetual adoration and home to the National Shrine of St. Maximilian Kolbe. During my retreat I will visit a shrine in Chicago dedicated to Mother Cabrini (St. Frances Xavier Cabrini). Admittedly, I don't know much about her, so I look forward to learning about her and asking her prayers. While on retreat, I will spend time praying before the Blessed Sacrament in adoration and do some spiritual reading as well. A theologian whose writing I greatly enjoy, Fr. Roch Kereszty, O.Cist who recently died from complications of Covid, authored a book before his death titled *Rekindle the Gift of God: A Handbook For Priestly Life*. I hope to make my way through this book for my prayer and reflection.

I'll spend my final five days in New Mexico. It will be the first time I've flown since March 2020 which is both exciting and scary at the same time. During this Year of St. Joseph I wanted to visit the miraculous staircase attributed to St. Joseph that was built at the convent of the Sisters of Loretto. The story goes that the architect forgot to build a staircase to the choir loft and nobody could figure out how to build one. A random, mystery man shows up, spends months there, builds a spiral staircase with no nails but only pegs, and used wood foreign to the area. The man showed up after a nine day novena to St. Joseph, hence why they attribute the staircase to St. Joseph. Could he have come back to earth for this project? I'm hoping to film a short informational video and release it as a Cup of St. Joe episode sometime in November. I'll also visit Roswell, New Mexico, to do some filming at the Monastery of Our Lady of Guadalupe. A Poor Clare nun named Mother Mary Francis, whose writings I have found spiritually beneficial was the founding Mother of the monastery, and is featured in a new book I wrote being released in 2022. I'll be filming some professional segments for the book with the nuns.

Please remember me in your prayers, for a good retreat and safe travels, and know you will have a remembrance in my prayers as well.
