

Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

Many of you may have followed on social media my recent visit to New Mexico. It was a packed three days.

Saturday night when I arrived in Albuquerque, I drove three hours to Roswell, New Mexico, the site of the 1947 UFO sighting and possible alien sighting, but also the home to the cloistered Poor Clare Colletine nuns. I celebrated Mass for the community and spoke with Mother Abbess for about an hour afterwards about one of their saintly founding members.

Sunday night I drove back to Albuquerque so I could visit Santa Fe on Monday. I visited the miraculous staircase of St. Joseph at the Loretto Chapel along with a few other holy sites. And Tuesday, I had the opportunity to visit a few places in Albuquerque, including the grave of a priest friend who died earlier this year.

I'd like to share a bit more about the Miraculous Staircase of St. Joseph. You may have seen my little video about it on social media, but I wanted to emphasize what struck me the most about the story. The chapel built without a staircase to the choir loft received a choir loft because of the sisters' devotedness to prayer. They prayed a novena to St. Joseph. Meaning, they petitioned St. Joseph for nine days to help them find someone to build the chapel. On the ninth day a carpenter or builder showed up and volunteered to build the staircase. The sisters took it as a miracle. And the staircase truly was miraculous because engineers and architects today do not know what is supporting it.

My takeaway- prayer is powerful and we see the fruit of prayer, we receive graces. Many of you have prayed novenas to the Lord, the Blessed Mother, or the saints. If there is some petition on your heart, consider praying a novena, and maybe you will receive an answer just like the Sisters of Loretto in Santa Fe.
