Dear Parishioners,

As our Christmas season comes to a close, I'd like to offer my sincere thanks to everyone who sent cards and gave gifts. I've tried my very best to reciprocate a card for a card, but if I missed you by chance, I apologize and remain grateful. Also, I am very grateful for everyone who has helped us to celebrate Christmas over the past few weeks. Our church, as usual, has been so beautiful, and the music has helped us to worship Christ Our Savior.

I'd like to share a tidbit into priestly ministry. The Church has seven sacraments. One of them being the Anointing of the Sick. The sacraments we celebrate are only administered to the living. If a person has already passed when I am called, I will only bless the body with holy water and say prayers of commendation for the departed soul. Should you or a family member be sick and near death, it is better to call in advance, so that the Anointing of the Sick may be celebrated and the apostolic pardon administered. You can always call the parish phone at any time, and tell the answering service it is an emergency and they will call me directly.

Also, I am so grateful to the many family members and parishioners in our community who bring Holy Communion to your elderly loved ones, neighbors, or act as an ambassador for our parish. Some parishioners have gone to neighboring parishes recently and have been denied Holy Communion in their pyx. Unfortunately it seems that this is the state of affairs in our area, but please know that I will continue to allow you to bring Holy Communion from our parish whenever you present yourself with a pyx.
