Dear Parishioners,

This past week at daily Mass the readings have been from the first book of Samuel. The story of Hannah is one that speaks to my special devotion to Our Lady of La Leche. Hannah was childless and went into the temple and prayed. She poured out her heart to God, made a promise to the Lord, and experienced peace after her prayer. God heard Hannah's prayer, remembering her, and giving her a child, whom she named Samuel.

Last week when I was in Florida, I spent time in prayer each day at the Shrine of Our Lady of La Leche in Saint Augustine, Florida. It's the oldest city in the US and is quite historic. The shrine to Mary there is the oldest in the United States.

It dates back to the 1600's. The statue is quite unique as it is the nursing Madonna. The shrine has a reputation of being a place of grace for couples praying to conceive a child. As I sat in the chapel praying my rosary, I couldn't help but wonder as each couple came in or child with their family if they had some connection to the shrine.

On social media, I asked for individuals to share names of couples. I received over 200 names and prayed for each individually before my rosary. I feel blessed to have them entrusted to me and pray for graces. I've received many grace reports over the years as I've taken this as a special charism for intercession.
