

# Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

The last few days I led over 40 of our parishioners on a pilgrimage to St. Louis and Chicago. I chose St. Louis because of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Snows. Since the parish in Namur had her as its patroness, I thought some people might like to see it. How the shrine emerged is very unique. It resulted from one of the missionary oblate priests who would write thank you notes to donors and share about his mission work. Over the years, people began coming to Belleville to learn more about Our Lady of Snows, who the priest wrote about, but there was no shrine. So slowly the campus was built up because of the priest's devotion and people responding to him.

It was important to me this year to bring people to the Mother Cabrini Shrine in Chicago. It is the 75th anniversary of her canonization and the Church declared a jubilee year and a holy door at the shrine. I first visited this shrine last year and wished it wasn't such a secret. I've described it as one of the most beautiful shrines I've visited in the United States. Mother Cabrini has quickly become one of my special saints for 2022.

There is a miracle story associated with Mother Cabrini in Chicago. A young infant named Peter Smith was born in the hospital where Mother Cabrini's sisters worked. Cabrini had already died at this point. Peter was born in the 1920s, during a time when it was common to put silver nitrate in a newborn's eyes. The religious sister erred in the amount and baby Peter was blinded by the mistake. The sisters spent all night in prayer, asking Mother Cabrini to obtain a miraculous healing for Peter. They put a relic of Mother Cabrini on the boy's eyes and the next day when the doctor examined him, he remarked they brought the wrong child because there was nothing wrong with the boy's eyes. Peter Smith's eyes were healed. And several years later, he would be ordained a Catholic priest. This miracle paved the way for Mother Cabrini to be beatified.

The saints are powerful intercessors. I have befriended saints throughout the years and encourage all to do the same.
