Dear Parishioners,

Many of you might recall that back in 2018 and 2019, I was away for the summer months taking classes at Mundelein Seminary. You might wonder what happened after that. Well I didn't write my thesis or take my comprehensive exam, so I have two things outstanding for the degree. I made the decision recently to finish the degree and first need to complete my thesis. I was able to spend a few days away over the holiday weekend last week and wrote another of the four chapters. I have two completed. My topic is about the Assumption of Our Lady. A simple request, when you pray that decade of the rosary (4th Glorious mystery) think of me and pray that I will bring the project to completion.

If you want to head to the theatres, I have two suggestions for you. Last weekend a new movie released in theatres titled *Gigi & Nate*, it tells the story of a quadriplegic young man and his service animal. In my published review of the film, I wrote about how the movie made me think about the consequences of our actions, in addition to the value of animals and the age-old question, why do people have to suffer. There is another movie that just came out on September 9th called *Lifemark*. This movie will only be in theatres for one week. It tells the story of David Scotton, who was adopted, and his search for his birth parents. It's a pro-life movie, because his birth mom was in an abortion clinic and couldn't go through with it and left. She gave David up for adoption. It's more of an adoption story which is a different take usually for a pro-life film. The actor Kirk Cameron plays David's adopted father in the movie. I had the opportunity to do media work for both movies, pre-screened them, wrote reviews, and interviewed the director of *Gigi & Nate* and David Scotton, whose story inspired by *Lifemark*.

Finally, on Labor Day, I made a trip to Sister Bay in the afternoon with a priest classmate of mine from seminary. I found a small little Orthodox Chapel in someone's backyard that I was aware of but previously couldn't find. I shared the story this past week on social media and perhaps in an upcoming column, I will share the differences between Catholicism and the Orthodox faith.
