

Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

Advent is going to be here before you know it. As a podcast host, I've already done several Advent themed interviews. November 27th is the First Sunday of Advent. It's not too early to begin thinking about that season as I'm sure you've also been thinking about your Christmas to-do list.

Advent is one of those seasons that sneaks up on us. How will you observe the season this year? There are lots of Advent devotionals and the parish provides the blue books free of charge. As an author of a seasonal devotional myself (Lent), I know there are tons of Advent resources by trusted authors. A religious sister named Sr. Miriam James has a devotional journal available from Ave Maria Press. It's so popular, that it usually sells out. I'm a big fan of a classic (in my opinion) from Mother Mary Francis titled "Come Lord Jesus." Personally, this year I plan to use a devotional with meditations from/by/about Padre Pio.

Advent also has other customs. For example, have you ever had an Advent wreath in your home? It might be a nice practice as a family to gather a few times each week and pray together around the wreath. There's a custom I plan to observe this year that I had heard of but never did myself, called the Jesse Tree. I just interviewed an author who has a book about that tradition. It'll release on Monday. Check social media for a link. It's a devotion that goes through the genealogy or family tree of Jesus. I plan to do a daily Advent Facebook show with the devotion too.

This past week I was able to escape to the woods for a few hours to bow hunt. Some have asked about the blessing of hunting equipment (guns and crossbows) held in Rosiere. This year the event was not planned or scheduled. It's something we could do in the future. With the gun violence in our country, it might be best to take this year off and assess the safest way to host that event. There will be an evening Mass on Saturday, November 19th at 7:30pm.

There is one schedule change this week: there will be no Wednesday Mass in Brussels. Instead there will be Mass on Friday, November 18th with the intentions that were scheduled for Wednesday.
