

# Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

The gospel for the first weekend of Lent is always the temptation of Jesus in the desert. Sometimes I have preached on the fittingness of hearing the gospel at the beginning of Lent, as a reminder of the temptation to abandon our Lenten discipline. I have been reading Pope Benedict XVI's *Jesus of Nazareth* for my upcoming STL Comprehensive Exam. He treats the temptation of Jesus and had an interesting insight. The three temptations of Jesus are an anticipation of what is to come in the public ministry of Jesus. The first temptation of changing stones into bread anticipates the multiplication of loaves and the great miracle of the Last Supper where bread is changed into the body and blood of Christ. The second temptation is answered by Christ on Mount Calvary as the crucified Christ. The final temptation related to power, is answered by Jesus in his ascension to Heaven in glory as king.

This upcoming week I will be away Tuesday-Friday to preach a retreat and a parish mission. On Tuesday and Wednesday I'll be preaching a retreat for a gathering of priests in Illinois. I have attended lots of retreats for priests before, but I have never preached one before. I have been the recipient of content but not the communicator of the content. I will give six talks over the two days. I'll be giving the following talks: 1) The French School of Spirituality for Priests; 2) An Examination of Conscience for Priests Based on St. Bernard of Clairvaux's Steps of Humility; 3) Priestly Friendship with God, the Saints, Spiritual Friends, and Others; 4) Listening and Living Mary's Messages; 5) How They Love Mary: Examples of Marian Devotion; 6) Mary in the Life of a Priest. On Thursday morning, I'll fly to San Antonio and give my Lenten Marian apparition talk at the Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes Thursday evening and preach a special Mass on Friday evening before returning to Wisconsin. Once I return, I'll not be away until late May.

During these days of Lent, let us persevere in prayer, self-denial, and almsgiving.
