

Father Edward's Notebook

Dear Parishioners,

If you have a good memory, you might remember that for two summers in 2018 and 2019 I was away for eight weeks to do advanced studies in theology. I returned on the weekends for Masses so many people might not have known of my absence. I still had one course to finish which I did during the spring of 2020. What was left to complete was the thesis. 2020-2021 posed issues with the pandemic and being an off campus student. I also lacked motivation to complete the thesis because I no longer was passionate about the topic I had selected. That's why I dragged my feet for two more years. I made a decision to complete the degree late in 2022 because I was simply embarrassed by always saying I hadn't finished and I also didn't like that it was always over my head like a rain cloud.

I completed my thesis in early January and passed my comprehensive exam in March. My thesis was on the theology of Mary's assumption as expressed in the homilies of St. Bernard of Clairvaux and St. Aelred of Rievaulx. I'm grateful to the people who continued to encourage me over the past several years to finish. This weekend I participated in commencement in Mundelein, Illinois. You might be curious what does an STL mean? It is called a Licentiate in Sacred Theology. In years past it was a license to teach in a Catholic university. More practically today, I can serve as a censor for the bishop when granting an imprimatur, advise on theological matters, and work on a cause for sainthood.

On another note, please keep in your prayers Fr. Steve who served our parish before I arrived. Many of you know that he has been sick for a long time. I have not spoken with him or visited him yet, but I'm told by others to pray for his health. To this end, one of his relatives from Lincoln, asked if I would lead a prayer service for him. As you know I love our roadside chapels. In 2018 I held two rosaries at our roadside chapels. I'd like to have this prayer vigil for Fr. Steve at the St. Peregrine Roadside Chapel at Rosiere. We would gather outdoors, so bring a lawn chair, and pray in front of the chapel, with the opportunity to go inside the chapel after. **Join us on Monday, May 22nd, at 6pm.** Should it be inclement weather, we will gather in the Rosiere church and pray.

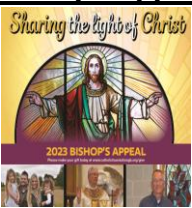
