Dear Parishioners,

As Catholics each year we remember our beloved dead during the month of November. As a country we solemnly remember those who have died in service to our country on Memorial Day. Many people will visit cemeteries over this weekend not just for our fallen war dead but to place flowers on the graves of loved ones. I take great pride in our cemeteries with the beautiful Grotto in Brussels and the chapels in the scattered cemeteries.

As we remember our war dead this weekend, I especially think of two saintly priest chaplains who have open causes for the sainthood. Fr. Emil Kapaun served in the Korean War and sacrificed greatly to serve the soldiers. There is an iconic photo of him celebrating Mass on the back of a Jeep. He was taken as a prisoner of war and died. Recently his remains were located and transferred to the Diocese of Wichita in Kansas. Fr. Vincent Capodanno was a military chaplain during the Vietnam War. When one platoon was under fire and many were hurt and dying he rushed in to offer the Last Rites. He fell as a casualty of his heroic service. I'm sure many of those in our parish who served could recount stories of the chaplains they knew during their time of service.

As we enjoy this three day holiday, let us not forget the reason why our country celebrates this weekend. It isn't for cookouts but to remember those who served and gave their life. Let's celebrate them and not forget about them.

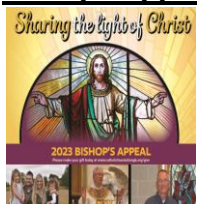
