Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

God is good, all the time! All the time, God is good!

Dear Parishioners,

Allow me to share with you the significant dates pertaining to our devotion to Our Lady of Champion to constantly remind you, my dear parishioners, of her important role in our lives as followers of Jesus Christ.

On October 9, 2023, the entire Diocese of Green Bay celebrated the Solemn Elevation of our Diocesan Shrine into a National Shrine. I also learned that, in 2009, Most Reverend David L. Ricken, Bishop of Green Bay, opened a formal Church investigation into the Marian apparitions that occurred in 1859 on the site of the Shrine.

After thorough reviews of the historical information regarding the apparitions, the life of Adele and as well as its consistency with Public Revelation as guarded by the Catholic Church, in 2010, Bishop Ricken declared the apparitions "Worthy of Belief" by the Authority of the Catholic Church. And in 2016, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops designated the grounds as a National Shrine, making it the first in the U.S. with an approved Marian Apparition. On April 20, 2023, the name of the Shrine was changed to "The National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion".

Upholding Bishop Ricken's aspiration to promote Marian devotion in honor of Our Lady of Champion, I personally enjoin you my dear parishioners to pray the novena in her honor every Saturday in our parish before the 4:00 pm anticipated Mass. With joy, the parish pastoral council under the worship committee would like to start this weekly devotion as we also start this new fiscal year 2024-2025. It is also my hope that one day, we will be able to procure a life size statue of Our Lady of Champion as we venerate before her loving presence seeking a deeper relationship with Jesus through His Mother.

We may not be able to visit her Shrine every day, but we will begin from our heart's desire to promote this devotion by praying the novena and rosary together as one parish.
