

What is a Mission Trip?

A mission trip is a short-term volunteer opportunity where people travel to a different place to make a difference in the lives of others. Mission Trips can be a transformative experience that helps people grow by stepping outside of their comfort zone. It helps people learn that the world does not revolve around them and that they may have a higher purpose in life.

Over the past 13 years, I have been on 12 mission trips through Catholic Heart Work Camp. We have discovered communities where faith comes alive through service. Catholic Heart Work Camp invites us to be part of something great through **love, service and connection**. By partaking in meaningful service projects, spiritual growth and lifelong friendships, we are equipping our youth to impact their world and deepen their relationship with God.

I have taken over 125 youth on mission trips twice to Charleston, SC, Billings, MT, St Louis, MO, Champaign, IL, Detroit Lakes, MN, Mishawakee, IN, Nashville, TN, Ashland, MT, twice Minneapolis/St Paul, MN and Farmington, MI. These experiences have changed our youth, realizing how fortunate we are to live where we do and have what we have. These experiences would not have been possible without your prayers and financial support.
